Unknown --except that mental health companies may not be able to fully utilize the LCPCs due to the prohibitive cost of obtaining this specialized endorsement. It is also unclear to me why it is being proposed that LCPCs must take extensive courses, obtain excessive hours of supervision, AND pass another licensing exam to work with families, when our LCSW and Licensed Psychologist colleagues are able to practice with families without obtaining special endorsements for marriage and family work. In researching doctoral and master's level programs in psychology and social work, I found that both social work and psychology programs may require ONE (1) "family" based course in their entire program and yet the NRS states the scope of their practice includes working with individuals AND families. As a clinician, previously a LMHC in another state who practiced extensively with couples, families, and individuals to have now become a LCPC here in Nevada this process seems excessive and unfair compared to other professionals working in this field. Individuals with CPC licensure should be evaluated on a case by case basis, to determine if the board is satisfied with their experience and education. There should be a grandfather component for those of us who have been practicing or who have experience from other states.

My license in another state allowed me to do couples and family counseling, which I did for seven years. There does not seem to be any recognition of that experience in these requirements. This seems like yet another example of the state of Nevada being excessively restrictive and territorial instead of allowing reciprocity and recognizing the experience that counselors from other states can bring. It further hinders the provision of counseling services to this state, where they are desperately needed. This endorsement essentially does nothing to expand the practice of the majority of CPCs due to its prohibitive regulations and costs.
